

People in Sin **Jesus** **God**

We all are sinful people (Romans 3:23). Examples of sin can be lying, stealing, and hatred (Exodus 20:1-17). Sin separates us from God (Isaiah 59:2). The penalty of sin is death (Romans 6:23). If we accept and confess that Jesus died for our sins on the cross, we are forgiven of sin (Ephesians 1:7 and Romans 10:9-10). Jesus “bridges” the gap! We can then be close to God (1 Peter 3:18).

What’s next?! Talk to Jesus as a friend, start reading your Bible (maybe the book of Matthew and the Psalms), and find a church that teaches on the Bible!


